PUBLIC COMMENT: *Mary and Eizo Kobayashi addressed the budget cuts with the Commission on Aging. The mentioned a letter they received from the City Manager that mentioned cuts to the senior center recreation and nutrition programs. They encouraged the Commission to be present at the next budget meeting on June 22 and make a statement in support of senior programs to be cut.*

Commissioners also discussed the possibility of attending the Farmer’s Market to do outreach to seniors who attend the downtown Music and Market. Commissioners agreed to table the work plan until the August meeting.*
Liaison Reports: Commissioner Leon attended the MCP Senior Action Meeting and reported that Laurel Zion gave a talk on Medications. Zion gave a wealth of information and was well received by the group. Leon reported that Route 8 was being discontinued due to low ridership.
Commissioner Rogers attended the Good Timers group at the Methodist Church and reported the group has approximately 30 seniors who attend and they often have very good speakers.
