**SUBJECT: REPORT ON THE OFFICIAL RESULTS OF THE NOVEMBER 4, 2014
CONSOLIDATED MUNICIPAL ELECTION**

Report in Brief

A Consolidated Municipal Election was held in the City of Concord on Tuesday, November 4, 2014, pursuant to Concord Resolution No. 14-31, calling for the election of three Councilmembers and one City Treasurer, and Resolution No. 14-62, asking the voters to decide on a Ballot Measure continuing approval of a one-half of one percent (0.5) transactions and use (sales) tax for an additional nine years to fund General Municipal Services (Ballot Measure Q). The election was conducted in the manner required by the provisions of the California Election Code for general law cities. The County Clerk of Contra Costa County, pursuant to the request of the City Clerk of the City of Concord, has duly canvassed the votes and has verified the results of the votes cast, which certification is now on file in the Office of the City Clerk of the City of Concord.

The returns of the votes cast in the election have been canvassed and the official results are as follows:

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Therefore, the newly-elected Councilmembers are Laura Hoffmeister, Timothy S. Grayson, and Ronald Leone.

For the position of City Treasurer, the following candidates received the following votes:

| <u>Candidate</u> | <u>Votes</u> | <u>Percentage</u> |
|--------------------|--------------|-------------------|
| Thomas J. Wentling | 17,129 | 80% |
| Louis Mazzarella | 4,305 | 20% |

Therefore, the newly-elected City Treasurer is Thomas J. Wentling.

On the question of whether to approve an ordinance amending the expiration date of an existing sales tax in Concord (Ballot Measure Q) the following votes were received:

Therefore, Ballot Measure Q passed, and a one-half of one percent (0.5%) Transactions and Use (Sales) Tax to fund general municipal services that was approved by a majority of the voters in November, 2010, and took effect in April, 2011, will be extended for a nine year period until 2025.

Recommendation for Action

Staff recommends the City Council adopt Resolution No. 14-83, accepting the results of the November 4, 2014 Consolidated Municipal Election and confirming the adoption of Ordinance No. 14-8. The results of the canvass of the election are declared on Exhibit A of the attached Resolution No. 14-83.

WHEREAS, a Consolidated Municipal Election was held in the City of Concord on Tuesday, November 4, 2014, pursuant to Concord Resolution No. 14-31 for the election of three Councilmembers and one City Treasurer; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Concord Resolution No. 14-62, a ballot measure, Ballot Measure Q, was also placed before the voters seeking extension of a one-half of one percent (0.5%) Transactions and Use (Sales) Tax for nine years to fund General Municipal Services; and

WHEREAS, the election was conducted in the manner required by the provisions of the California Election Code for general law cities; and

WHEREAS, the County Clerk of Contra Costa County, pursuant to the request of the City Clerk of the City of Concord, has duly canvassed the votes and has verified the results of the votes cast, which certification is now on file in the Office of the City Clerk of the City of Concord.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONCORD DOES RESOLVE that the canvas of votes by the County Clerk on file in the City Clerk's Office is hereby confirmed, and the votes cast for the candidates for Councilmember are as follows:

11 **IT IS THEREFORE FURTHER RESOLVED AND DETERMINED AS FOLLOWS:**

12 **Section 1.** The whole number of ballots cast in the election was 26,133 ballots, resulting in a
13 voter turnout of 46.14 percent based on a voter registration of 56,633 voters.

14 **Section 2.** The results of the votes cast in the election are attached to this resolution as Exhibit
15 A.

16 **Section 3.** Timothy S. Grayson, Laura M. Hoffmeister, and Ronald E. Leone were duly
17 elected as Councilmembers for terms of four years.

18 **Section 4.** Thomas J. Wentling was duly elected as City Treasurer for a term of four years.

19 **Section 5.** Ballot Measure Q passed and the voters approved an extension of a one-half of
20 one percent (0.5%) Transactions and Use (Sales) Tax for nine years to fund General Municipal
21 Services, which will expire in 2025.

22 **Section 6.** By passage of Measure Q, the people of the City of Concord authorize adoption of
23 Ordinance No. 14-8.

24 **Section 7.** The City Clerk shall administer the oath of office and present the certificate of
25 election to each duly-elected official.

26 **Section 8.** This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.



ORDINANCE NO. 14-8

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CONCORD MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 3 (REVENUE AND FINANCE) CHAPTER 3.15 (TAXATION), ARTICLE V (TRANSACTIONS AND USE TAX) BY EXTENDING AN EXISTING VOTER-APPROVED TRANSACTIONS AND USE TAX TO BE ADMINISTERED BY THE STATE BOARD OF EQUALIZATION

WHEREAS, by law, all funds from a Measure Q Continuation Measure must stay in Concord to maintain local services and no funds can be taken by Sacramento; and

WHEREAS, the Measure Q Continuation Measure requires independent Citizens’ Oversight, mandatory financial audits, and yearly reports to the community to ensure the funds are spent as promised; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of the Measure Q Continuation Measure does not increase the sales tax Concord residents currently pay; and

WHEREAS, the Measure Q Continuation Measure will provide continued funding for numerous City programs, including police patrols and gang prevention services, park and recreation programs, and street and pothole repair; and

WHEREAS, continued funding from this Measure will maintain after-school programs, anti-gang activities, and recreation programs that keep youth and teens off the streets, out of trouble and away from drugs and gangs; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to continue to address service priorities that the public has identified as being important to them, such as 911 emergency response times, neighborhood police patrols, police officers, gang prevention and crime investigation services, city street and pothole repair, senior services and nutrition programs, and youth and teen programs; and

WHEREAS, in November 2010, the voters of Concord adopted a local revenue measure (“Measure Q”), to mitigate cuts to local services caused by State takeaways and the Great Recession; and

WHEREAS, Measure Q established a general transactions and use tax (“sales tax”) of one-half of one percent (0.5%), which is codified at Title 3 (Revenue and Finance), Chapter 3.15

1 (Taxation) Article V (Transactions and Use Tax), Sections 3.15.360 through 3.15.500 of the Concord
2 Municipal Code; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the revenues raised by Measure Q have helped the City stay solvent during the
4 period since it was adopted; however, Measure Q is scheduled to expire; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the City's 10-Year Financial Forecast estimated that if Measure Q were to expire,
6 \$4 million in annual budget reductions would be required to address the decline in City revenues
7 currently received from Measure Q, which in turn would require the City to make severe cuts to the
8 services it currently provides, adversely affecting public safety services including 9-1-1 emergency
9 response times, police officers, gang prevention and crime investigation services, and neighborhood
10 police patrols, along with other City services, such as road maintenance, youth sports and recreation
11 programs, city parks and playgrounds, and senior services and the Senior Center; and

12 **WHEREAS**, all funds from a local revenue measure must stay in Concord to maintain local
13 services and cannot be taken by the State; and

14 **WHEREAS**, a local revenue measure ensures fiscal accountability by requiring independent
15 citizens oversight, mandatory financial audits, and yearly reports to the community; and

16 **WHEREAS**, at its June 3, 2014 meeting, the City Council adopted a budget for FY 2014-15
17 that recognized the need for additional revenue to maintain and preserve the level of services desired
18 by residents of the City; and

19 **WHEREAS**, at a public hearing on July 29, 2014, the Council considered placing a measure
20 on the ballot for the November 4, 2014 General Election seek voter approval of an extension of
21 Measure Q; and

22 **WHEREAS**, after that hearing, the City Council concluded that all of the information
23 presented indicated that, to maintain the revenue necessary to preserve existing service levels, the
24 Council should ask the voters of the City to approve a 9-year extension of Measure Q, continuing the
25 current assessment of a local transactions and use tax, the revenue from which could be used to
26 support general municipal services; and

27 **WHEREAS**, on the basis of the foregoing, the City Council, by adopting Resolution 14-62,
28 determined that it was appropriate to place a measure before the voters at the November 4, 2014

1 general election regarding a 9 year extension of the general transactions and use (sales) tax originally
2 authorized by Measure Q; and

3 WHEREAS, in the Consolidated Municipal Election Conducted on November 4, 2014, a
4 majority of the voters voted to approve the Measure Q Continuation Measure;

5 WHEREAS, the tax approved as a result of the adoption of the Measure Q Continuation
6 Measure will continue to be imposed on the sale of tangible personal property and the storage, use, or
7 other consumption of such property. The tax rate will continue to be one-half of one percent (0.5%) (a
8 half cent for each dollar) of the sales price of the property. The tax revenue will continue to be
9 collected by the State Board of Equalization and remitted to the City. The tax extension will be in
10 effect for 9 years (through 2025), and will then expire automatically, unless terminated earlier by a
11 unanimous vote of the City Council.

12 **THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONCORD RECOGNIZES THE DESIRE**
13 **OF THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF CONCORD AND DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

14 **Section 1.** The People of Concord find that all Recitals are true and correct and are
15 incorporated herein by reference.

16 **Section 2.** Concord Municipal Code Title 3 (Revenue and Finance) Chapter 3.15 (Taxation)
17 Article V (Transactions and Use Tax), is hereby amended by the italicized language:

18 **3.15.360 Title.**

19 This ordinance shall be known as the Concord Transactions and Use Tax Ordinance. The City
20 of Concord hereinafter shall be called "City." This ordinance shall be applicable in the
21 incorporated territory of the City.

22 **3.15.370 Operative date.**

23 "Operative Date" means the first day of the first calendar quarter commencing more than 110
24 days after the adoption of this ordinance.

25 **3.15.380 Purpose.**

26 This ordinance is adopted to achieve the following, among other purposes, and directs that the
27 provisions hereof be interpreted in order to accomplish those purposes:
28

1 (a) To impose a retail transactions and use tax in accordance with the provisions of pt. 1.6
2 (commencing with § 7251) of div. 2 of the Revenue and Taxation Code and § 7285.9 of pt. 1.7
3 of div. 2 which authorizes the City to adopt this tax ordinance which shall be operative if a
4 majority of the electors voting on the measure vote to approve the imposition of the tax at an
5 election called for that purpose.

6 (b) To adopt a retail transactions and use tax ordinance that incorporates provisions identical to
7 those of the Sales and Use Tax Law of the State of California insofar as those provisions are
8 not inconsistent with the requirements and limitations contained in pt. 1.6 of div. 2 of the
9 Revenue and Taxation Code.

10 (c) To adopt a retail transactions and use tax ordinance that imposes a tax and provides a
11 measure therefore that can be administered and collected by the State Board of Equalization in
12 a manner that adapts itself as fully as practicable to, and requires the least possible deviation
13 from, the existing statutory and administrative procedures followed by the State Board of
14 Equalization in administering and collecting the California State Sales and Use Taxes.

15 (d) To adopt a retail transactions and use tax ordinance that can be administered in a manner
16 that will be, to the greatest degree possible, consistent with the provisions of pt. 1.6 of div. 2 of
17 the Revenue and Taxation Code, minimize the cost of collecting the transactions and use taxes,
18 and at the same time, minimize the burden of record keeping upon persons subject to taxation
19 under the provisions of this ordinance.

20 **3.15.390 Contract with State.**

21 Prior to the operative date, the City shall contract with the State Board of Equalization to
22 perform all functions incident to the administration and operation of this transactions and use
23 tax ordinance; provided, that if the City shall not have contracted with the State Board of
24 Equalization prior to the operative date, it shall nevertheless so contract and in such a case the
25 operative date shall be the first day of the first calendar quarter following the execution of such
26 a contract.

27 **3.15.400 Transactions tax rate.**

1 For the privilege of selling tangible personal property at retail, a tax is hereby imposed upon all
2 retailers in the incorporated territory of the City at the rate of one-half of one percent (0.5%) of
3 the gross receipts of any retailer from the sale of all tangible personal property sold at retail in
4 said territory on and after the operative date of this ordinance.

5 **3.15.410 Place of sale.**

6 For the purposes of this ordinance, all retail sales are consummated at the place of business of
7 the retailer unless the tangible personal property sold is delivered by the retailer or his agent to
8 an out-of-state destination or to a common carrier for delivery to an out-of-state destination.

9 The gross receipts from such sales shall include delivery charges, when such charges are
10 subject to the state sales and use tax, regardless of the place to which delivery is made. In the
11 event a retailer has no permanent place of business in the State or has more than one place of
12 business, the place or places at which the retail sales are consummated shall be determined
13 under rules and regulations to be prescribed and adopted by the State Board of Equalization.

14 **3.15.420 Use tax rate.**

15 An excise tax is hereby imposed on the storage, use or other consumption in the City of
16 tangible personal property purchased from any retailer on and after the operative date of this
17 ordinance for storage, use or other consumption in said territory at the rate of one-half of one
18 percent (0.5%) of the sales price of the property. The sales price shall include delivery charges
19 when such charges are subject to state sales or use tax regardless of the place to which delivery
20 is made.

21 **3.15.430 Adoption of provisions of State law.**

22 Except as otherwise provided in this ordinance and except insofar as they are inconsistent with
23 the provisions of pt. 1.6 of div. 2 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, all of the provisions of pt.
24 1 (commencing with § 6001) of div. 2 of the Revenue and Taxation Code are hereby adopted
25 and made a part of this ordinance as though fully set forth herein.

26 **3.15.440 Limitations on adoption of State law and collection of use taxes.**

27 In adopting the provisions of pt. 1 of div. 2 of the Revenue and Taxation Code:
28

1 (a) Wherever the State of California is named or referred to as the taxing agency, the name of
2 this City shall be substituted thereof. However, the substitution shall not be made when:

3 (1) The word "State" is used as a part of the title of the State Controller, State
4 Treasurer, State Board of Control, State Board of Equalization, State Treasury, or the
5 Constitution of the State of California

6 (2) The result of that substitution would require action to be taken by or against this
7 City or any agency, officer, or employee thereof rather than by or against the State
8 Board of Equalization, in performing the functions incident to the administration or
9 operation of this Ordinance.

10 (3) In those sections, including, but not necessarily limited to sections referring to the
11 exterior boundaries of the State of California, where the result of the substitution would
12 be to:

13 a. Provide an exemption from this tax with respect to certain sales, storage, use
14 or other consumption of tangible personal property which would not otherwise
15 be exempt from this tax while such sales, storage, use or other consumption
16 remain subject to tax by the State under the provisions of pt. 1 of div. 2 of the
17 Revenue and Taxation Code, or;

18 b. Impose this tax with respect to certain sales, storage, use or other
19 consumption of tangible personal property which would not be subject to tax by
20 the state under the said provision of that code.

21 (4) In §§ 6701, 6702 (except in the last sentence thereof), 6711, 6715, 6737, 6797 or
22 6828 of the Revenue and Taxation Code.

23 (b) The word "City" shall be substituted for the word "State" in the phrase "retailer engaged in
24 business in this State" in § 6203 and in the definition of that phrase in § 6203.

25 **3.15.450 Permit not required.**

26 If a seller's permit has been issued to a retailer under § 6067 of the Revenue and Taxation
27 Code, an additional transactor's permit shall not be required by this ordinance.

28 **3.15.460 Exemptions and exclusions.**

1 (a) There shall be excluded from the measure of the transactions tax and the use tax the amount
2 of any sales tax or use tax imposed by the State of California or by any city, city and county, or
3 county pursuant to the Bradley-Burns Uniform Local Sales and Use Tax Law or the amount of
4 any state-administered transactions or use tax.

5 (b) There are exempted from the computation of the amount of transactions tax the gross
6 receipts from:

7 (1) Sales of tangible personal property, other than fuel or petroleum products, to
8 operators of aircraft to be used or consumed principally outside the county in which the
9 sale is made and directly and exclusively in the use of such aircraft as common carriers
10 of persons or property under the authority of the laws of this State, the United States, or
11 any foreign government.

12 (2) Sales of property to be used outside the City which is shipped to a point outside the
13 City, pursuant to the contract of sale, by delivery to such point by the retailer or his
14 agent, or by delivery by the retailer to a carrier for shipment to a consignee at such
15 point. For the purposes of this paragraph, delivery to a point outside the City shall be
16 satisfied:

17 a. With respect to vehicles (other than commercial vehicles) subject to registration
18 pursuant to Chapter 1.05 (commencing with Section 4000) of Division 3 of the
19 Vehicle Code, aircraft licensed in compliance with Section 21411 of the Public
20 Utilities Code, and undocumented vessels registered under Division 3.5

21 (commencing with Section 9840) of the Vehicle Code by registration to an out-of-
22 City address and by a declaration under penalty of perjury, signed by the buyer,
23 stating that such address is, in fact, his or her principal place of residence; and

24 b. With respect to commercial vehicles, by registration to a place of business out-of-
25 City and declaration under penalty of perjury, signed by the buyer, that the vehicle
26 will be operated from that address.

1 (3) The sale of tangible personal property if the seller is obligated to furnish the
2 property for a fixed price pursuant to a contract entered into prior to the operative date
3 of this ordinance.

4 (4) A lease of tangible personal property which is a continuing sale of such property,
5 for any period of time for which the lessor is obligated to lease the property for an
6 amount fixed by the lease prior to the operative date of this ordinance.

7 (5) For the purposes of subparagraphs (3) and (4) of this section, the sale or lease of
8 tangible personal property shall be deemed not to be obligated pursuant to a contract or
9 lease for any period of time for which any party to the contract or lease has the
10 unconditional right to terminate the contract or lease upon notice, whether or not such
11 right is exercised.

12 (c) There are exempted from the use tax imposed by this ordinance, the storage, use or other
13 consumption in this City of tangible personal property:

14 (1) The gross receipts from the sale of which have been subject to a transactions tax
15 under any state-administered transactions and use tax ordinance.

16 (2) Other than fuel or petroleum products purchased by operators of aircraft and used or
17 consumed by such operators directly and exclusively in the use of such aircraft as common
18 carriers of persons or property for hire or compensation under a certificate of public
19 convenience and necessity issued pursuant to the laws of this State, the United States, or any
20 foreign government. This exemption is in addition to the exemptions provided in §§ 6366 and
21 6366.1 of the Revenue and Taxation Code of the State of California.

22 (3) If the purchaser is obligated to purchase the property for a fixed price pursuant to a
23 contract entered into prior to the operative date of this ordinance.

24 (4) If the possession of, or the exercise of any right or power over, the tangible personal
25 property arises under a lease which is a continuing purchase of such property for any period of
26 time for which the lessee is obligated to lease the property for an amount fixed by a lease prior
27 to the operative date of this ordinance.
28

1 (5) For the purposes of subparagraphs (3) and (4) of this section, storage, use, or other
2 consumption, or possession of, or exercise of any right or power over, tangible personal
3 property shall be deemed not to be obligated pursuant to a contract or lease for any period of
4 time for which any party to the contract or lease has the unconditional right to terminate the
5 contract or lease upon notice, whether or not such right is exercised.

6 (6) Except as provided in subparagraph (7), a retailer engaged in business in the City
7 shall not be required to collect use tax from the purchaser of tangible personal property, unless
8 the retailer ships or delivers the property into the City or participates within the City in making
9 the sale of the property, including, but not limited to, soliciting or receiving the order, either
10 directly or indirectly, at a place of business of the retailer in the City or through any
11 representative, agent, canvasser, solicitor, subsidiary, or person in the City under the authority
12 of the retailer.

13 (7) "A retailer engaged in business in the City" shall also include any retailer of any of
14 the following: vehicles subject to registration pursuant to Chapter 1.05 (commencing with
15 Section 4000) of Division 3 of the Vehicle Code, aircraft licensed in compliance with Section
16 21411 of the Public Utilities Code, or undocumented vessels registered under Division 3.5
17 (commencing with Section 9840) of the Vehicle Code. That retailer shall be required to collect
18 use tax from any purchaser who registers or licenses the vehicle, vessel, or aircraft at an
19 address in the City.

20 (d) Any person subject to use tax under this ordinance may credit against that tax any
21 transactions tax or reimbursement for transactions tax paid to a district imposing, or retailer
22 liable for a transactions tax pursuant to pt. 1.6 of div. 2 of the Revenue and Taxation Code with
23 respect to the sale to the person of the property the storage, use or other consumption of which
24 is subject to the use tax.

25 **3.15.470 Amendments.**

26 All amendments subsequent to the effective date of this ordinance to pt. 1 of div. 2 of the
27 Revenue and Taxation Code relating to sales and use taxes and which are not inconsistent with
28 pt. 1.6 and pt. 1.7 of div. 2 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, and all amendments to pt. 1.6

1 and pt. 1.7 of div. 2 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, shall automatically become a part of
2 this ordinance, provided however, that no such amendment shall operate so as to affect the rate
3 of tax imposed by this ordinance.

4 **3.15.480 Enjoining collection forbidden.**

5 No injunction or writ of mandate or other legal or equitable process shall issue in any suit,
6 action or proceeding in any court against the State or the City, or against any officer of the
7 State or the City, to prevent or enjoin the collection under this ordinance, or pt. 1.6 of div. 2 of
8 the Revenue and Taxation Code, of any tax or any amount of tax required to be collected.

9 **3.15.490 Annual audit; citizens' oversight.**

10 By no later than December 31st of each year after the operative date, the city's independent
11 auditors shall complete a report reviewing the collection, management and expenditure of
12 revenue from the tax levied by this Article. Additionally, there shall be a committee consisting
13 of no fewer than five members of the public to review and report on the receipt of revenue and
14 expenditure of funds from the tax authorized by this Article. The committee members shall be
15 either Concord residents or representatives of Concord businesses. Prior to the operative date,
16 the City Council shall adopt a resolution establishing the composition of the committee, setting
17 the terms of office of the committee members, and defining the scope of the committee's
18 responsibilities, which at a minimum shall include reviewing the annual auditor's report and
19 making recommendations to the City Council for use of the tax revenue. The committee's
20 report and recommendations shall be completed by a date to allow for it to be considered as
21 part of the annual budget process. The committee's report and recommendations shall be a
22 matter of public record and shall be considered by the City Council at a public meeting. Also
23 prior to the operative date, the City Council shall appoint at least a quorum of the members of
24 the committee; and the Council shall complete the appointment of members of the committee
25 by the end of fiscal year 2011.

26 **3.15.500 Termination date.**

1 The authority to levy the tax imposed by this ordinance shall expire on the fourteenth
2 anniversary of the last day of the calendar quarter preceding the operative date, unless
3 terminated earlier by a unanimous vote of the City Council.

4 **Section 3.** The findings for this ordinance in compliance with the California Environmental
5 Quality Act (“CEQA”) are the same as those set forth in the City’s Resolution No. 14-31 calling for an
6 election on this Ordinance. The CEQA findings in Resolution No. 14-31 are incorporated herein by
7 reference.

8 **Section 4.** If any provision of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or
9 circumstance is held invalid, it shall be severable and the remainder of the ordinance and the
10 application of such provision to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

11 **Section 5.** This Ordinance relates to the levying and collecting of the City transactions and use
12 taxes. The City Council, by a two-thirds vote of the Council by adopting Resolution 2014-62,
13 approved submission of this Ordinance to the voters at an election to be held on November 4, 2014.
14 Upon approval by a majority of the voters of the city, and upon adoption of a resolution declaring the
15 election results, the Mayor shall hereby be authorized to attest to the adoption of this Ordinance by the
16 voters of the City by signing where indicated below.
