CONTRACT WITH LSA ASSOCIATES – CenterCal Commercial Project EIR

Motion was made by Grayson and seconded by Leone to enter into a contract with LAS Associates for work in an amount up to \$193,699 to prepare an environmental impact report for the CenterCal Commercial Project, to be fully reimbursed through a reimbursement agreement between the City and CenterCal Properties. Motion passed by the following vote of the Council:

CONTRACT WITH KITTELSON & ASSOCIATES – CenterCal Commercial Project Traffic Study

Motion was made by Grayson and seconded by Leone to enter into a contract with Kittelson & Associates, Inc. (KAI) for work in an amount up to \$167,743 to prepare a traffic study for the proposed CenterCal commercial project located at 2001-2003 Diamond Boulevard, which will be fully reimbursed pursuant to a reimbursement agreement between the City and CenterCal Properties. APPROVAL OF CONTRACT CHANGE ORDER – Citywide Bridge Repair Program Group 1 Bridges Project, Project No. 2342

Motion was made by Grayson and seconded by Leone to approve a contract change order in the amount of \$63,975 and a related budget transfer in the amount of \$45,000 for the Citywide Bridge Repair Program Group 1 Bridges Project, Project No. 2342. APPROVAL OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENTS – NCE, Bellecci & Associates, Pavement Engineering, Inc. – Design Services

Motion was made by Grayson and seconded by Leone to approve a Professional Services Agreement with NCE of Richmond in the amount of \$198,000 to provide design services for Measure Q Pavement Repair Project 1, Project No. 2359; approve a Professional Services Agreement with Bellecci and Associates of Concord in the amount of \$192,517 to provide design services for Measure Q Pavement Repair Project 2, Project No. 2361; approve a Professional Services Agreement with Pavement Engineering, Inc. of San Luis Obispo in the amount of \$57,495 to provide design services for Measure Q Pavement Repair Project 3, Project No. 2362; approve a Professional Services Agreement with Pavement Engineering, Inc. of San Luis Obispo in the amount of \$126,090 to provide design services for Measure Q Pavement Repair Project 4, Project No. 2364; and authorize the City Manager to execute the agreements. AWARD OF CONTRACT TO RON DUPRATT FORD – Two 2016 Ford F-350 4x2 ¾ Ton Flatbed Dump Trucks, RFB #2339

Motion was made by Birsan and seconded by Leone to select Ron DuPratt Ford as the lowest responsive bidder and award the purchase of two new 2016 Ford F-350 4x2 ¾ ton flatbed dump trucks in the amount of \$66,360.92. Motion passed by the following vote of the Council:
