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Subject: **Accept the improvements for Citywide Sewer Lateral Replacement Program, Project No. 2244, constructed by Overmiller, Inc. dba Roto-Rooter of Concord; and direct the City Clerk to file a Notice of Completion**

Report in Brief

Overmiller, Inc. DBA Roto-Rooter of Concord has completed all work on the Citywide Sewer Lateral Replacement Program, Project No. 2244.

Recommended Action

Staff recommends that the City Council accept the improvements for Project No. 2244 (Citywide Sewer Lateral Replacement Program) constructed by Overmiller, Inc. DBA Roto-Rooter; and direct the City Clerk to file a Notice of Completion.

Background

On November 18, 2015, the City Council awarded a construction contract in the amount of \$150,000 to Overmiller, Inc. DBA Roto-Rooter for Project No. 2244. The Project was created to fund an annual program to replace City maintained lower sewer laterals (from the property line to the main) in various residential locations throughout the City. It was anticipated that the project's first year funding would fund the replacement of 10 sewer laterals previously identified as needing replacement by the Public Works Sewer Division, and other similar improvements on an on-call basis as could be afforded by the contract.

Analysis

During the program's first year of implementation, the 10 sewer laterals identified as needing replacement by the Public Works' Sewer Division and 11 others have been replaced; for a total of 21 replaced laterals. The program also replaced a segment of 6-inch sewer main on Galindo Street between Concord Avenue and Willow Pass Road. RotoRooter has satisfactorily completed their work.

Financial Impact

The project was completed within the allocated budget.
