Report in Brief

Appoint an applicant as a City of Concord representative on the John Muir/Mt. Diablo Community Health Fund Board to fill an unscheduled vacancy created by the resignation of Ernesto Avila.

Recommended Action

Staff recommends appointing one applicant as a City of Concord representative on the John Muir/Mt. Diablo Community Health Fund Board with a term ending December 31, 2017.

Background

There is an unscheduled vacancy on the John Muir/Mt. Diablo Community Health Fund Board. On June 28, 2016 the City Council announced a recruitment and set Tuesday, July 12, 2016 at 5 p.m. the deadline line for receipt of applications to the City Clerk. There is one unscheduled vacancy on the CHF with a term ending December 31, 2016.
