Weapons Station Master Developer selection, park plan moving forward

The City is moving forward with the selection of a Master Developer for Phase 1 of the Concord Naval Weapons Station Reuse Project. A public meeting is slated to be held on Tuesday, April 5 to choose between two firms, Catellus Development Company and Lennar Concord LLC. Concurrently, the East Bay Regional Park District is working to turn 2,500 acres of the base into a world-class regional park. The next planning meeting is March 24
