#### Concord Essential Services Measure on November 2014 Ballot



The City Council approved placing a measure on the November 2014 ballot, asking voters to extend Measure Q to protect and maintain essential local city services. Measure Q was adopted by Concord voters in 2010, but it is scheduled to expire soon. If enacted, the Measure Q continuation could generate funds to maintain city services that residents have identified as important, including 9-1-1 emergency response, neighborhood police patrols, gang prevention programs, street and pothole repair efforts, and youth and senior programs.
