Measure Q - Concord's Continuation of Essential Services Measure - is on the November 4 ballot to protect and maintain local city services. Measure Q simply extends, without raising taxes, the existing voter approved measure to maintain city services that residents have identified as important, including 9-1-1 emergency response, neighborhood police patrols, gang prevention programs, street and pothole repair efforts, and youth and senior programs. Continuing Measure Q means locally-controlled funds for local projects and services, with funding that cannot be taken from the State.
