New sandbag area open 24/7

Bags, sand and shovels are now available for residents to build sandbags at the City Corporation Yard, 1455 Gasoline Alley. In the past, access to the sandbag area was limited to business hours. This year, a station is provided just outside the main gate which allows residents to build sandbags 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The limit is 25 sandbags per household.



November office closures



City of Concord offices will be closed on Monday, Nov. 12 for Veteran's Day, and from Monday, Nov. 19 through Friday, Nov. 23 for unpaid furlough days and the Thanksgiving holiday. Employees are taking 13 unpaid furlough days during the 2012-13 fiscal year, equivalent to a five-percent reduction in pay, to help balance the General Fund budget.
