

## What Is A Vacation House Check?

---

The Neighborhood Patrol is part of the Volunteer Program. Members have been trained to perform a thorough inspection of your property while you are away from home. Their inspections include the following:

- 1 Perimeter check of the property to make sure everything appears secure.
- 2 Physical and/or visual check of all doors and windows to make sure they are secure.
- 3 Verification of vehicles left on the property.
- 4 Verification of any people found on the property.

## Who Can Use This Service?

---

Any Concord resident who owns a house or condominium can take advantage of this free service. This service does *not* apply to vacant property or apartments.

## How Do You Arrange For This Service?

---

Just complete the one-page form and submit it to the Volunteer Program at the Police Department at least 2 days prior to your planned departure. Forms can be obtained online\* or at the Police Headquarters located at **1350 Galindo St.** Completed forms may be mailed or faxed to us at 691-6640.

## What Happens If I Am Having Someone Stay At My House?

---

If you are planning to have someone stay at your house during the day, then the vacation House Check would not be appropriate. However, if they are there, periodically, in the evening, we would still be able to provide the daytime service.

## When Is This Service Available?

---

This service is available year-round, Monday–Saturday. The inspections are done during the daytime when most neighborhoods are quiet and many people are at work.

## What Happens If They Find Something Suspicious?

---

The Neighborhood Patrol has been trained to notify a police officer if they encounter something that seems abnormal.

## How Much Does This Service Cost?

---

This service is provided absolutely free for the residents of Concord. There is no limit to the number of times you can use this service.
